BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE

A briefly presentation of the association TransEducation

Our association TransEducation officially started its activities in September 2016. The name TransEducation expresses the intention to "transfer education" or "bring education from one place to another".

In particular, TransEducation is a contact point for Islam-related and philosophical education, information and at least prevention.

TransEducation...

- ...carries out educational and further training programmes as well as socio-cultural programmes on the topic of Islam & philosophy,
- ...initiates, accompanies and evaluates youth work projects and activities among young people,
- ...carries out interreligious education, further education and youth work projects for Muslim and non-Muslim
- ...and participates in corresponding cooperations.
- ...strives for education around Islam & philosophy.
- ...also deals with controversial topics.
- ...pursues a preventive purpose.
- ...focuses on young Muslims and those interested in the discourse on Islam.

Other areas of activity may be defined by resolution of the Board/Team.

The consequences of the current Islam crisis are manifold and farreaching. Young people - especially Muslims - are trying to understand and classify the events surrounding Islam. Many questions and fears arise for them, which is why they often look for answers online. The internet, in turn, is often used to radicalise and mobilise young people (of all religions).
